Competitive Event participants will need to **print the letter containing information for the individual events from the FCCLA website** along with the **time schedule**. Participants **will not** receive letters via US postal service. Please check the website to determine the competition time of your student. **Note:** the schedule **could change after registration** so you must check for changes after the revised schedule is posted outside the competition room following registration for the events. Participants will go to the assigned area and register for the event by turning in all required materials along with the affiliation confirmation with participants names highlighted. Events will take place at the Lubbock Civic Center and Holiday Inn/Towers except for Culinary Arts which takes place off site.

A list of qualifications for the 2012-2013 regional **officer candidates** will be posted to the website in January. Please review with your voting delegate the election procedure found in the region constitution and have your voting delegate bring a #2 lead pencil to the House of Delegates session. Each chapter may have one voting delegate in attendance. **The voting delegate badge will be in the registration packet that must be picked up before the House of Delegates session. Notice the HOD is at 1:30 PM.**

Chapters may turn in contributions to the Region I **Community Service Project** on Friday during general registration. See the FCCLA website for specific information about the Community Service Project.

Hotel information is available on the Texas FCCLA website. **Curfew** is set in the hotel at 11:00 p.m. This means that members should be in their rooms by 11:00 p.m. with doors closed and voices should not be heard from the halls or through the walls. We are so happy to serve as the host hotels during the Family, Career & Community Leaders of America, Region I.

In partnership with your advisors we will be enforcing the 11:00 p.m. curfew established for all attendees. Accordingly, we would like to communicate the **basic expectations** for all guests within the hotel by providing a basic outline for you as described below:

- * Each advisor is responsible for the behavior of his/her group at all times.
- * Each advisor should set specific behavior guidelines for his/her group with specific consequences for misbehavior.
- * Please refrain from throwing objects from stairs or balcony.
- * It is unsafe to hang from railings or slide down banisters.
- * All TV or music levels in rooms or in public areas such as lobby, pool area, halls, etc. must be at an acceptable volume.
- * Be aware that overfilling the elevators could cause a malfunction. Please limit each elevator car and do not overload.
- * Hotels have the option of imposing any sanctions they may deem necessary to maintain order, even to the point of expulsion of the person or persons causing disturbances or damage to their property.
- * Kindly keep in mind that there are **many guests not affiliated** with FCCLA staying in the hotel. Respect the peace and quiet of all guests by practicing these things:
 - * Remember that groups of people make more noise than one person.
 - * Do not slam doors.
 - * Keep your voices down when traveling from the elevators to your room.
