Travel “Beyond the Limits,” and assist with your Region’s Community Service Project. Bring your items or donations to the drop off areas at the specified locations.

Each region has selected the following charities:

- **Region I: American Red Cross in Lubbock**
Suggested items are travel size toiletries. The items will be turned into comfort kits for the U.S. Troops, and families in need. *(Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.)*
- **Region II: Cook Children’s Hospital in Fort Worth**
Suggested items are infant and playroom toys, movies (G or PG), books, crafts, and toiletries. The items will be donated in order to comfort and encourage the children to get better. *(Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.)*
- **Region III: Scottish Rite Hospital in Dallas**
Suggested items are **new** Matchbox/Hot Wheels cars and handheld/travel games. Items donated will be given to both children and teen patients. *(Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.)*
- **Region IV: Ronald McDonald House of Galveston**
Suggested items are paper products, cleaning supplies, **canned** fruits, meats, juices and **new** clothing for children and adults. *(Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.)*
- **Region V: Make A Wish Foundation of the Rio Grande Valley**
Suggested items are toys, board and handheld/computer games, iTunes and gaming gift cards, books, and decks of cards. *(Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.)*
