

FCCLA Officer Elections, 2012-13

Region I FCCLA chapters did not submit enough officer candidates for a full slate of officers for the 2012-13 school year. Based on the region constitution/bylaws, if this occurs, chapters may nominate one affiliated officer candidate from the floor in the House of Delegates session. Once nominated, the nominee will present the required speech and answer the fact and thought question. The officer candidate to be nominated from the floor will need to bring the following completed items to turn in when they check in at the holding room: Officer Application, Letter of Recommendation, Code of Conduct form, and a copy of the chapter affiliation form with the candidates name highlighted.

After all nominations have been received and have presented, the voting delegates will then vote on the officers. If there are more than a total of 17 candidates, the students that submitted their application by the December 1 deadline will be guaranteed an office and those nominated during the meeting will be considered for the remaining positions.

Article VI of Regional Constitution

Article VI, Election of Officers

Section I: Each chapter may have one officer candidate. Chapters with more than fifty (50) affiliated members may have two officer candidates. The maximum number of officer candidates for each chapter is two. A school with multiple chapters may not have more than four candidates. *If a region does not have 17 officer candidates submitted by the deadline, nominations will be taken from the floor during the House of Delegates meeting. Candidates nominated from the floor must meet all officer requirements and follow the procedures outlined for officer elections.* It is the duty of the House of Delegates to elect regional officers.
