Each region has selected the following charities:

- **Region I: American Red Cross in Odessa**  
Suggested items are travel size toiletries. The items will be turned into comfort kits for the U.S. Troops, and families in needs. (*Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.*)
- **Region II: American Red Cross in San Angelo**  
Suggested items are cases of bottled water or travel sized toiletries. The items will be turned into comfort kits for the U.S. Troops, and families in needs. (*Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.*)
- **Region III: Buckner Children's Home in Dallas**  
Suggested item to be donated are *new* children's shoes. (*Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.*)
- **Region IV: Advocacy Center for Children of Galveston County in Galveston**  
Suggested items are travel-size deodorant and toothpaste, combs, brushes, towels and washcloths, diapers, *new* clothing newborn to age 18. (*Donations must be turned in Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.*)
- **Region V: Animal Defense League of Texas in San Antonio**
