Members focus on a specific community need and carry out a unique service project that meets that need.

Application for the Community Service Award will be mailed to the chapters in the Fall from national headquarters. The deadline for the application is February 15, 2009. The written presentation will be judged on clarity of goal, project creativity, impact on community and the use of Family and Consumer Sciences skills and the extent to which the project promotes a better understanding of Family and Consumer Sciences and Family, Career, and Community Leaders of America.

All participants who enter the competition will be recognized at the state leadership meeting in Corpus Christi.
