

## House of Delegates House Rules

- 1. The purpose of this session is to transact business of the state association, to elect officers, and inform the group of how to work thoroughly using proper parliamentary procedure.
- 2. Each affilated chapter may only have one voting delegate.
- 3. Voting delegates should be aware of their responsibilites prior to the meeting time and should come to the meeting fully prepared to accept and carry out their duties.
- 4. Voting delegates must wear their voting delegate badges. Voting delegates will sit in the reserved section.
- 5. Voting delegates who are out of order will be asked to leave and their vote will be voided.

- 6. Changes to the constitution and bylaws need to be submitted in written form 45 days prior to the state confrence and sent to the state advisor.
- 7. Only two people will be allowed to speak for a motion and only two may speak against a motion. The ones speaking must state their name and school. Each speech will be limited to one minute each.
- 8. No one will permitted to enter or leave after the meeting has been called to order, except in the case of an emergency.
  - 9. The constitution and bylaws may be amended by two-thirds (2/3) of those delegates present.
- 10. The nominating committee for specific office placements will interview the elected slate of officers.
