

## **TEXAS FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP TEXAS ASSOCIATION FAMILY, CAREER AND COMMUNITY LEADERS OF AMERICA**

Family, Career and Community Leaders of America awards one scholarship to a member who has been a Region or State FCCLA Officer in addition to meeting the scholarship eligibility requirements. This scholarship is awarded at the beginning of the recipient's college career.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

Applications should be completed in full and returned to the Association, which will carry out the application process, evaluation procedure and determination of recipients of the scholarships awarded.

### **DEADLINE IS FEBRUARY 1, 2024**

All applications must be submitted on-line with all required documents and signatures by 11:59pm CST on FEBRUARY 1, 2024. No exceptions will be made.

### **APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible a student must:

- Be a resident of the state of Texas
- Be a 2024 graduate of a Texas high school
- Have an overall high school grade average of 85
- Be a Texas Region or State Officer
- Meet entrance requirements of Texas college or university which offers a degree in Family and Consumer Sciences
- Enroll in a Texas accredited college with a Family and Consumer Sciences department in the Fall of 2024
- *MAJOR IN ANY AREA OF FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCES*
- Include test scores of American College Testing (ACT) and/or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)
- Submit one **typed** copy of the application form, transcript of grades for last grading period, and two letters of recommendation.
- Attach two copies of an autobiography

### **RECEIVING THE SCHOLARSHIP**

To be awarded the Texas Farm Bureau scholarship, the winner of the must attend the Texas FCCLA State Leadership Conference in April 2023 held in Dallas, Texas. In the event the winner does not attend, the scholarship will be awarded to an alternate winner.
