

## SUGGESTION FROM EVALUATORS WHEN COMPLETING FCCLA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

- 1. If possible, use 10 point font or larger on the application.
- 2. Be sure application is legible/not handwritten.
- 3. Answer every question on the application.
- 4. Make sure all information is complete.
- 5. Proof read the application before submitting it.
- 6. Have someone else proof read the application.
- 7. Have all required individuals sign the application; double check it.
- 8. Be specific, included everything you did in FCCLA...if active, add more than "FCCLA member" –put down everything you have done and projects that you participated in.
- 9. Ask for help in completing the application—counselors or advisors
- 10. When writing the essay, check sentence structure and content.
- 11. Include two letters of recommendation.
- 12. Follow directions for the personal essay/narrative 2 pages max, normal margins, and double spaced. There are also instructions on how to head your paper follow directions to the "T"
